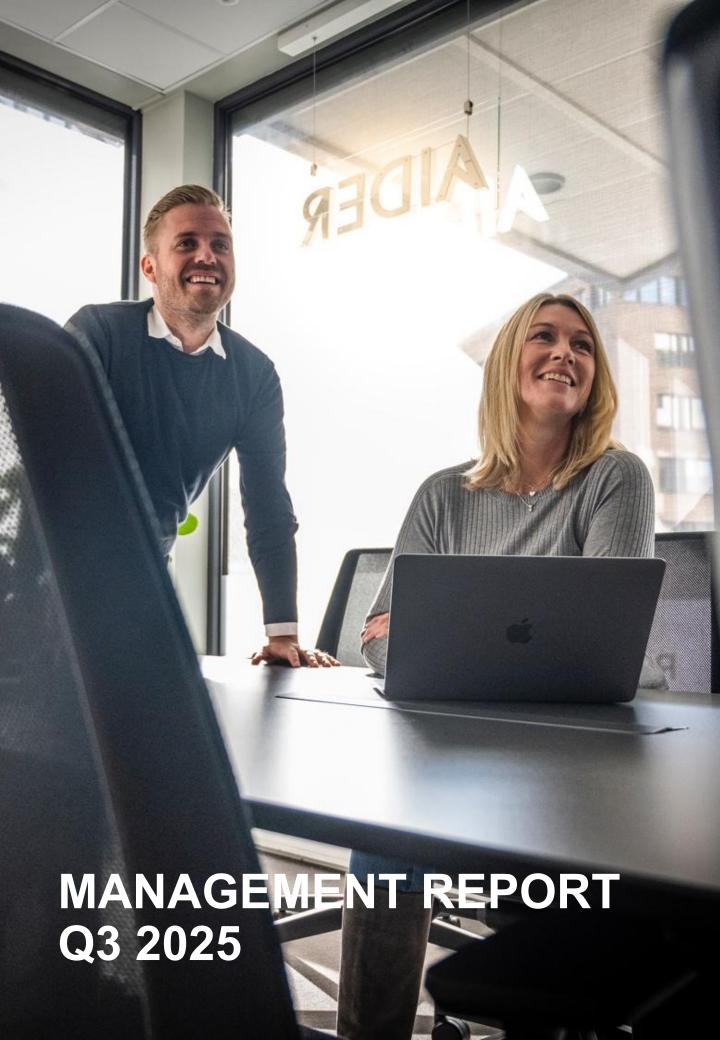
INTERIM REPORT Q3 2025 AIDER KONSERN





Financial performance

Aider Konsern continued its robust trajectory throughout the third quarter of 2025. Total operating income for Q3 2025 reached NOK 442.5 million, representing a strong increase of 39.1% compared to NOK 318.1 million in Q3 2024. This significant year-on-year growth was primarily driven by the continuous inclusion of acquired companies into the Group. Year-to-date (YTD) total operating income also showed strong performance at NOK 1,420.2 million, marking a 46.9% increase compared to YTD 2024 (NOK 973.4 million). The operational context during the quarter included a slightly slower market pace, which is reflected in the organic growth year to date of 4.7%.

This growth has given Aider the number 1 position in the Norwegian accounting market, confirmed in Q3 by the industry report by Regnskap Norge. Aider has closed 21 M&A deals in the first 3 quarters with last year revenues of MNOK 385. The first 3 quarters have included expansion to 3 new countries; Sweden, Denmark, and Poland. Also, Aider has after the end of Q3 launched a law firm – Aider Legal – of more than 50 lawyers. This expansion into new markets has significantly increased the cost of external advisors as well as management time to make this possible.

EBITDA adjusted for non-recurring items for Q3 2025 was MNOK 51.9, up from NOK 51.7 million in Q3 2024. However, the EBITDA adjusted margin for the quarter declined to 11.7%, compared to 16.2% in Q3 2024. This margin contraction is partly a result of the elevated M&A and integration activity that occurred during the quarter, where integration work also has influenced revenues, as certain employees have focused on integration projects rather than client activity. Furthermore, margin contraction is also a result of a quicker realization of benefits from AI & automation than planned, combined with somewhat slower organic growth than planned. Since there are some latencies in the recruitment process, we are experiencing some overcapacity that will level out in one to two quarters to bring back the margins to normal levels.

Non-recurring items significantly impacted the quarter, amounting to NOK -40.6 million in Q3 2025, a substantial increase from NOK -10.4 million in the same quarter of the previous year. This increase is related to the success of the Aider's M&A activities. Aider has entered three new countries and established a law firm, and through this established four new platforms for growth. Consequently, there has been a need to use external advisors significantly more than previous quarters. Furthermore, as Aider does M&A in existing cities colocating offices is a low hanging synergy. Short term, this results in an increase in redundant property costs from acquisitions. Other integration cost is developing in line with the underlying growth in M&A.

The Group's balance sheet reflects the successful M&A strategy. Net Interest-Bearing Debt (NIBD) stood at approximately NOK 1733.2 million at the end of Q3 2025, compared to NOK 818.3 million at the end of Q3 2024. This increase is partly a result of the tap-issue conducted in Q2 to secure financing for the robust near-term acquisition pipeline, most notably funding the cash portion of the transactions in Poland and add-on acquisitions in Norway.

The Group's cash movements in Q3 continued to reflect the strategic focus on executing the acquisition-led growth plan. Cash Flow from Operating Activities remains positive on a year-to-date basis, despite the temporary margin pressures. Furthermore, the quarter saw higher working capital requirements which led to a negative effect on cash and contributed to the increase in NIBD.

Bond reporting

At the end of Q3 2025, the Group's leverage ratio (Net interest-bearing debt to EBITDA), based on bond terms is 6.92. This leverage ratio would be 5.34 without the bond term caps on one-off costs and estimated synergies. This is increased compared to the Q2 figure of 5.10, reflecting the increase in interest-bearing debt used to fund the recent acquisition pipeline, the high-one off costs and the bond-term cap on one-off items allowed in the incurrence test calculation, costs relating to international expansion, and the temporary dip in the Q3 LTM adjusted EBITDA. The ratio is expected to improve over the coming quarters as the acquired companies are fully integrated, and their value-accretive earnings are consolidated.

Continued success with M&A activities

Aider maintains a positive and active momentum within M&A, continuing to execute on its planned geographic expansion. The following acquisitions have been completed year-to-date 2025:

Aider can now grow in 4 new markets (Sweden, Denmark, Poland, and law firms), opening up to a great deal of new opportunities. Consequently, the M&A pipeline is the largest in Aider's history, giving us strong confidence in reaching/increasing our growth targets for the coming year. The Group has completed a total of 9 acquisitions during the quarter, bringing the accumulated total to 21 for the year. This includes the acquisition of MDDP Outsourcing in Poland, which has established our initial platform in a new European market. This particular acquisition adds 300 employees to the Aider Group. The MDDP Outsourcing transaction is the largest to date in Aider's history.

Our international expansion plans are well underway, with commercial agreements reached on additional M&A targets. We are actively focusing on closing several major new M&A targets in our new markets and anticipate announcing the completion of these transactions before the end of 2025.

Outlook

Looking ahead, Aider is poised to continue its dynamic growth strategy, with a strong focus on both strategic acquisitions and organic development.

After 30th of September, Aider has closed an additional four acquisitions with an additional LTM EBITDA adjusted of NOK 48 million, primarily within Aider Legal, which there are plans to include in Q4. Following the landmark agreement to acquire MDDP Outsourcing in Poland, we are actively finalizing transactions in both Sweden and Denmark. This strategic move into new geographic markets will diversify our revenue streams and establish Aider as a key player in new markets. The M&A pipeline going forward is at an all time high with an estimated NOK 200m+ in EBITDA of potential transactions. As a result, Aider expects the leverage ratio to improve over the coming quarters.

In addition to geographic expansion, Aider continues its vertical growth with the launch of Aider Legal. This initiative will offer specialized legal services, complementing our existing financial and advisory offerings.

While our M&A activities are set to accelerate and contribute to an improvement in the reported leverage ratio during the next quarters, the outlook for organic growth remains strong, albeit slightly more subdued compared to previous periods. We will continue to invest in technology, automation, and our "People First" culture to enhance service delivery and maintain our position as the most attractive workplace in the industry, ensuring sustainable, long-term value creation

NOTE 1 – ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES

General information

Aider Konsern (the group) consists of Aider Konsern AS (the company) and its subsidiaries. The head office is located at Karl Johans gate 37, 0162 Oslo.

Aider Konsern's consolidated statements for Q3 2025 were authorized for issue by the board of directors on November 13th, 2025.

Basis for preparation

The condensed consolidated interim statements have been prepared according to IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting and should be read in relation with the annual consolidated financial statement for 2024.

The accounting policies applied are the same as in the annual report, unless otherwise stated below in the following notes.

In the preparation of the interim accounts the management have used estimates and assumptions which have effect on the income statement and valuation of assets and liabilities, as well as uncertain assets and liabilities on the reporting date accordance to good accounting principes. Areas with high degree of estimates and complexities are described in the notes.
